# Homework policy: support for pupils and parents

Homework can be on paper or Glow and can cause confusion. Parents want to help and support and are maybe not able to do. It was felt there needs to be greater clarity. Show My Homework has been used in other schools but due to Aberdeenshire Council policies and data protection this has not been used in The Gordon Schools. There were issues also with this system due to it not being able to adapt to changes i.e. timetable/teachers. Teams was felt the best system to use. There are 3 – 4 difference sources of homework and this could be discussed with staff with a suggestion of having one place for everything. It was also noted that some pupils have homework weekly, and some are not given homework. There is educational evidence that pupils do not benefit from being overwhelmed with homework. If this does happen pupils/parents can speak to guidance so this can be explained to teachers. Parents need to be aware they can do this.

Maths and English are keen to have an evening session for parents on how to help with literacy/numeracy and to show what resources are available. It is important to support parents and that they do not do homework.

School to think about sending out a survey asking for responses as to how do young people access learning via their phone/device and how do they access learning out with school.
